The engine, mounted on a dedicated transport stand, required careful handling and precise securing due to its value and sensitivity. Any disruption to the delivery timeline could affect maintenance operations, potentially delaying the engine change and disrupting wider operational planning.

With a defined delivery window in place and multiple parties involved in the process, the requirement demanded a reliable, well-coordinated approach to ensure the engine arrived safely and in line with expectations

Precision planning with controlled execution

Freightline responded quickly to a late-afternoon request, sourcing a compliant articulated vehicle equipped with an air-ride trailer to meet the specified handling requirements, ensuring the safe transport of the engine in line with strict aerospace handling standards.

The dedicated vehicle was deployed to the site early the following morning and arrived as scheduled. It remained in position while loading preparations were completed. Once the engine had been secured in accordance with the airline's detailed strapping guidelines, photographic confirmation was provided to meet the client's approval requirements and support the controlled release process before the vehicle was authorised to depart.

As delays earlier in the day impacted the original delivery schedule, Freightline proactively issued an updated arrival time, ensuring transparency with all stakeholders and maintaining clear communication throughout the movement to keep expectations aligned. The delivery proceeded smoothly, aligning with operational expectations and ensuring the engine was delivered safely and in line with the client's requirements, while maintaining full visibility throughout.
